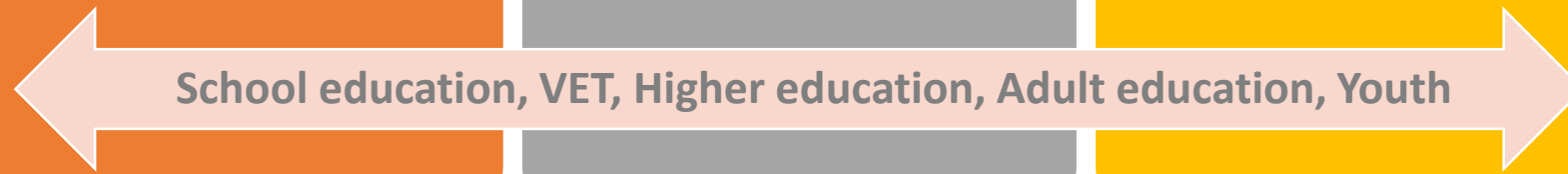

Learning mobility of individuals – managed by NA



1. Students and doctoral candidates:

- **studies or traineeships from 2 up to 12/24 months**: physical mobility (for minimum 2 months) an **optional** virtual component
- **short-term mobility for studies or traineeships** (5-30 days physical mobility) combined with a **compulsory** virtual component
- **BIPs**: short-term mobility for studies (5-30 days physical mobility) combined with compulsory virtual component

2. Recent graduates and post-docs:

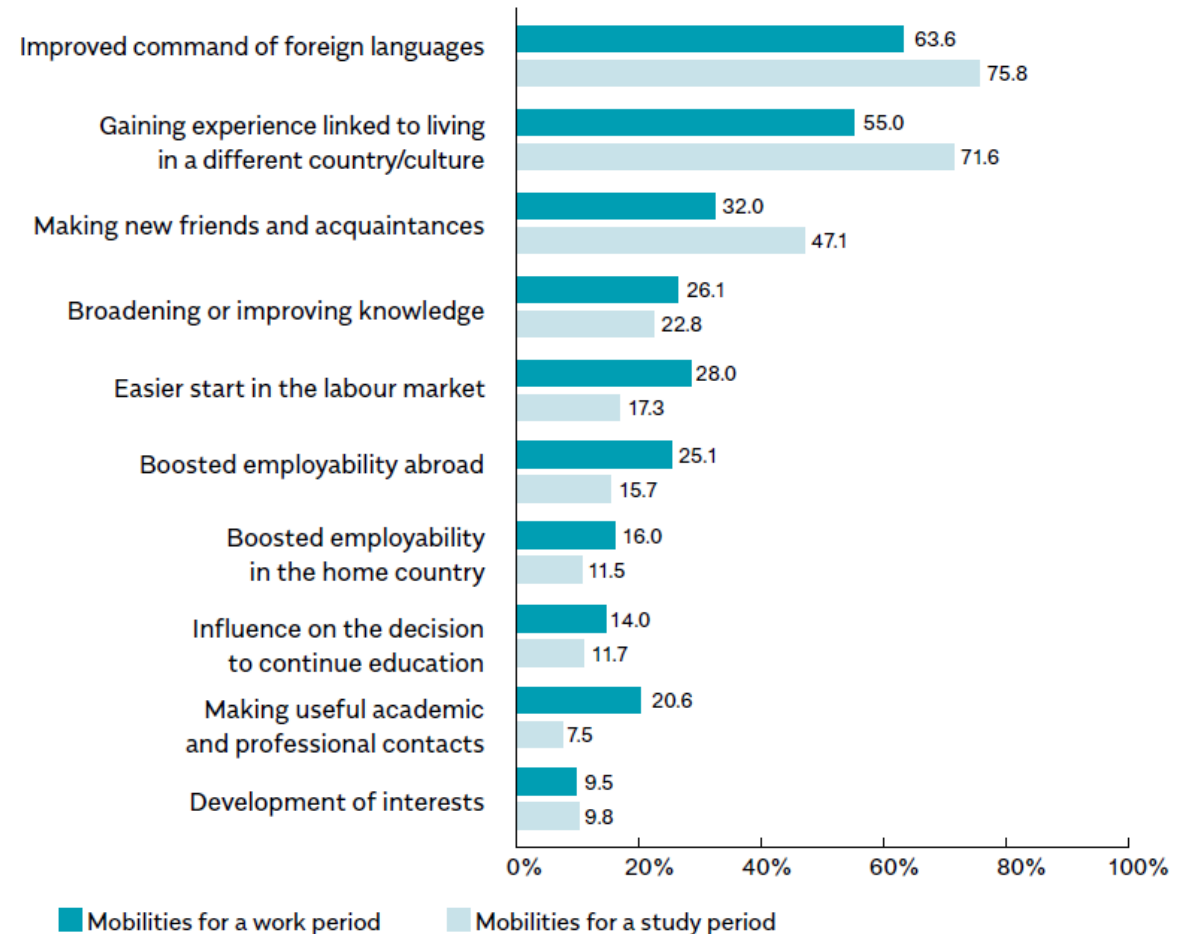
- **traineeships from 2 up to 12 months**: physical mobility (for minimum 2 months) with an **optional** virtual component
- **short-term mobility for traineeships** (5-30 days physical mobility) combined with a **compulsory** virtual component
- **BIPs**: short-term mobility (5-30 days of stay abroad) combined with compulsory virtual component.

Erasmus+ Higher education Action 1

Key benefits for students participating in mobilities:

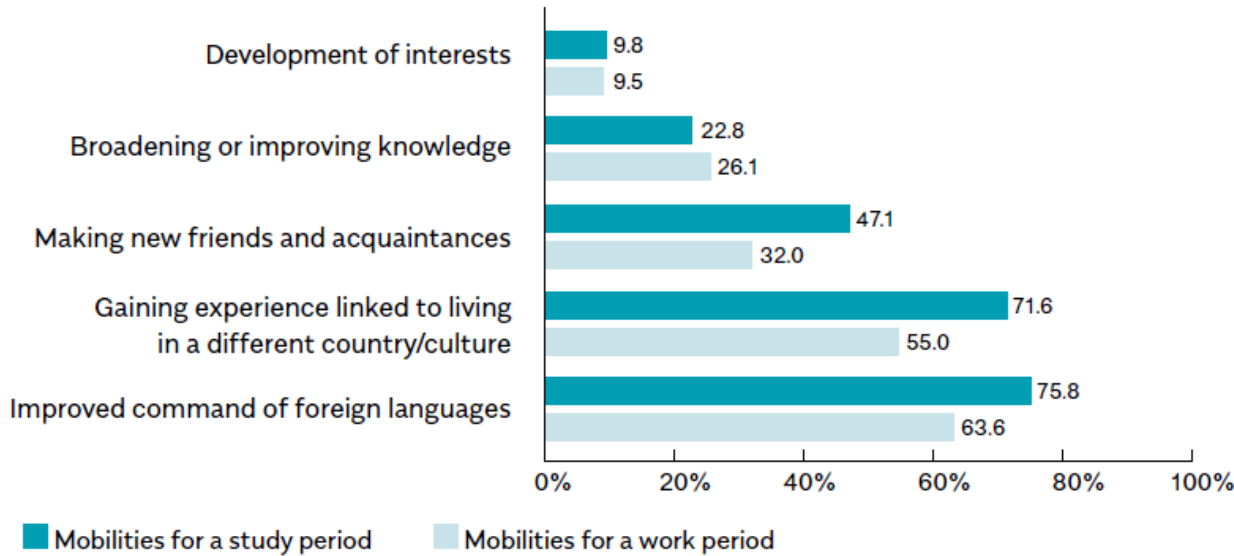
- improving foreign language skills,
- experiencing life in another country and culture,
- gaining new friends and acquaintances,
- development of soft competences, e.g., intercultural ones, improvement of self-esteem, development of interests.

(n = 6,877)

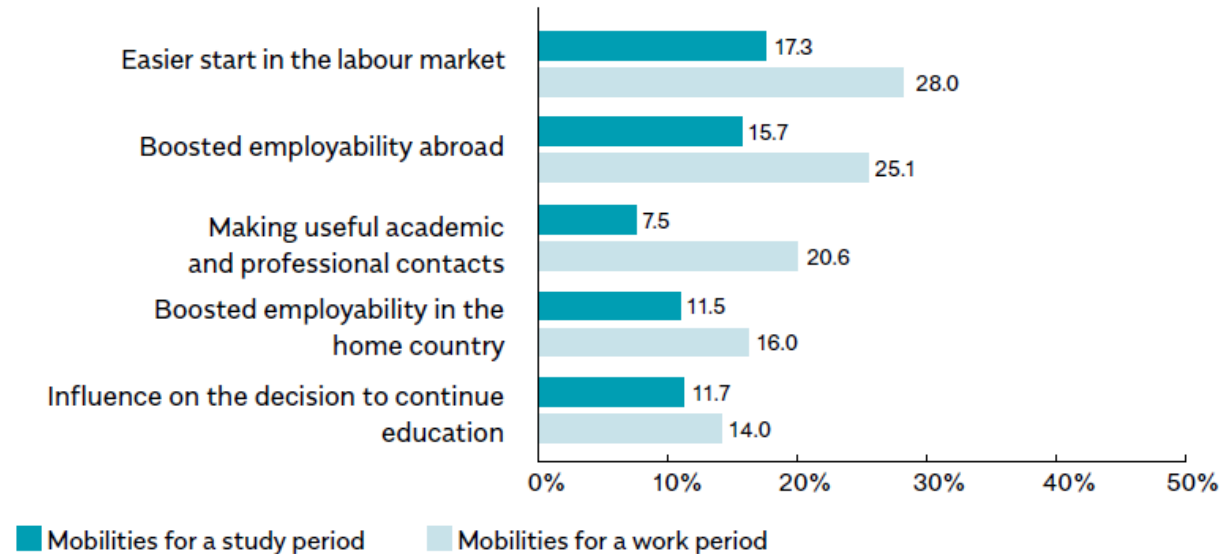

Learning mobility of individuals - managed by NA



Opportunities for staff members of HEIs

- mobility for teaching and training from 2/5 days up to 2 months: physical mobility (for minimum 2/5 days) with an **optional** virtual component;
in case of **invited staff from enterprises** minimum duration: 1 day of physical mobility;
- **BIPs**: short-term mobility (5-30 days of stay abroad) combined with compulsory virtual component

COOPERATION PARTNERSHIPS – GENERAL OBJECTIVES

to increase quality of education

Cooperation among organisations and institutions

COOPERATION PARTNERSHIPS - managed by NA

- **Budget amounts:** up to 400.000 EUR
- **Project durations:** 12 months to 36 months
- **Number of participating organisations:** Minimum 3 organisations from 3 Programme Countries
- **Call 2022 – deadline:** March 2022 (?)

EUROPEAN UNIVERSITIES – managed by EACEA

This action supports the emergence of bottom-up networks of higher education institutions, which will bring cross-border cooperation to the next level of ambition, through the development of joint long-term strategies for top-quality education, research and innovation, based on a common vision and shared values.
